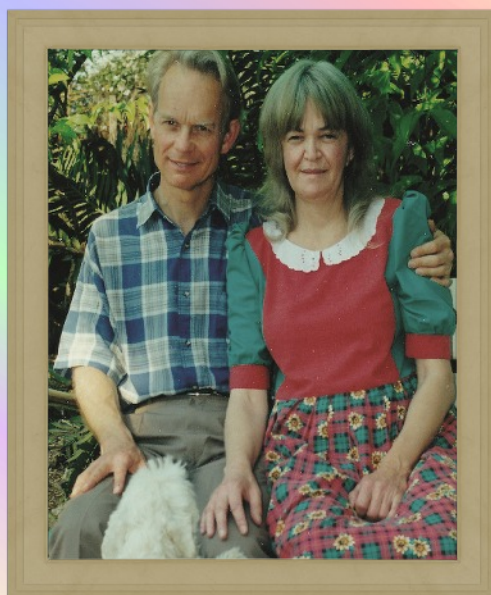


My Journey



From an orphan heart
to being 'accepted in the Beloved'

'In the beginning'

This is a very condensed version of my testimony, there are many, many people who have influenced my life and pointed me to Jesus in every circumstance. Too many to mention. If you read this you will know who you are. To you I say 'thank you' with all my heart.

My transition of having an orphan mentality to an absolute anshakeable assurance of knowing beyond a shadow of a doubt that I am fully loved and fully accepted by God has been a very lengthy journey. The reason being was that I took years to accept that actually the Lord Jesus Christ loved me for who I was to Him rather than by what I did for Him. I needed to come to the place where my whole life was flowing in the rest and assuredness of who I am in Christ.

Only recently have I truly come into the revelation and experiential knowledge of the truth of the word of God which says that I am **"accepted in the beloved"**. The other thing that I find quite ironic is that I was ministering with an orphan heart. It was quite a shocking experience when the Holy Spirit gently said to me.. **"Cindy you don't have to try and impress me with your gifting"** I love you completely and totally, apart from any giftings, talents or abilities!!

Let me tell you from experience. It's so much easier to come into a place of knowing who you are in Christ when you actually don't have any special giftings, talents and abilities, because then you fully realise in a big hurry that "Jesus I am nothing without You". There is no opportunity for being confident in your own abilities simply because you don't have any!! You will only be confident in who He is through you.

In the beginning

Born in Pietermaritzburg, KwaZulu-Natal and raised in Howick, KZN, I started playing the piano at the age of four. This musical ability was also discovered by the teaching staff during my school years, and I was often called upon to play for the school choir and for morning assembly. I was born with a facial deformity known as **Crouzons Syndrome**. I have come across this deformity in many other people as well, some being far more severe than mine used to be. People would stare, they somehow seemed to think that if you looked strange, your intelligence was also lacking. Children would often mock and tease me. I personally didn't think much of my appearance either, I was acutely aware of the fact that I was born different or 'ugly' and longed to be among those who were considered by myself and others to be 'beautiful'. I must say though that in the midst of this there were those who were kind-hearted and overlooked the facial deformities and accepted me just as I was; adults and children alike.

We were not very well off as a family, but I had a few facial operations by a surgeon in Pietermaritzburg which was arranged by a man who had become a family friend and whom I married at the age of eighteen. From this marriage came a daughter and two sons, who were miraculously born without any facial deformities! Even though we didn't realise it at the time, as I look back over the years I acknowledge that it was a wonderful demonstration of God's absolute undeserved grace and mercy as I did not have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ at the time. In fact I was very far from God's plan for my life.

My husband and I lived a very worldly lifestyle and got worldly results! What do I mean by 'worldly'? Well we lived a lifestyle void of the life-giving counsel and word of an incredibly loving Saviour. Many times I was asked to play music for different functions, basically anywhere background or dance music was needed! So initially the gifting the Lord had so graciously given me was most definitely not used to glorify His Name, and neither did the lifestyle we lived.

Heartache and hardship were our portion as a family for many years. Extreme adverse circumstances surrounding the birth of my last child, a son, caused me to run into the arms of my Saviour Jesus Christ, and I was gloriously born again in Hazel's parents home just before his birth. Hazel was a dear friend of mine who had faithfully supported me through one of the most difficult times in my life. From the time I was born again was when my change of heart began. At the time we as a family were living in Welkom, Free State, where we remained about five years.

Leaving the old life behind

Soon after I was born-again I had an outstanding function that I had committed too. So we transported my big organ to a hall in Welkom, but as the evening progressed and people were getting drunk, all I wanted to do was leave, and could hardly wait for the evening to draw to a close! Since then the desire to play secular music has faded and died. I also entered the Yamaha festival in section five in which I qualified to play in the Regional finals where I came second for the Free State. Yet it all came and went and the medals and the certificate for what they were worth, got lost somewhere along the way!!

Back to Pietermaritzburg

We decided to move back to Pietermaritzburg from Welkom where once again due to difficult circumstances we found ourselves moving house several times. It was in Pietermaritzburg however when, whilst working in a music shop, the wife of a well known plastic surgeon looked at me and said "You have crouzon's syndrome".

Her name was Daisy Losken. She then mentioned to me that her husband was part of a cranio-facial team who could surgically normalise my face which would help to make me more acceptable socially! A further blessing was that the operation would be done free of charge!

I went to see the surgeon, a Dr. Wolfgang Losken, an amazing plastic surgeon, and the process of preparation began. Arrangements for me to consult with the rest of the cranial facial team were made. The team consisted of a maxilla facial surgeon, a plastic surgeon, an orthodontist, a neurosurgeon, an anaesthetist and the theatre staff who wore masks with flowers printed on them for the occasion.

The operation itself was eight hours long. Post operatively I was in I.C.U. for three days and a further two weeks in the general ward. but it all went well praise God, thanks to the prayers of family, church family and friends and God's incredible faithfulness.

As the years continued so did the hardships and trials. My husband developed a heart condition and passed away at the age of fifty seven in July 1989 after having a heart by-pass a few years previously, so I was widowed at a very young age.

Life continued and my daughter later married a very special man, and I have four beautiful grandchildren, with whom I have beautiful memories of imparting some of my musical knowledge to, and my granddaughter has passed on some of her musical knowledge to me! They all love music, and we have great 'jam' sessions together. I believe the Lord is doing a work of restoration in my two sons, and it is my prayer that as a family we will live our lives to glorify the Lord.

My season of widowhood was twelve years. After my husband passed away I decided that if the Lord should choose that I marry again, my desire was that my future husband be one who had never married. And it was so! My husband Alex and I have been married for nearly twenty three years now. All glory to the Lord!

For those of you who desire to get married one day, I must mention this; allow the Lord to bring you to a place where you are totally fulfilled in Jesus, where getting married is not an issue or a concern. You are content and at peace with your relationship with the Lord Jesus, so loneliness doesn't even enter your thought because you are enjoying the intimacy you have with the lover of your soul, and Jesus is everything. When I came to the place where it didn't matter whether I married or not, Abba Father brought it all together.

A little about my musical background

Music has always played an integral part of my life, and my children have grown up with me ministering and different church functions and meetings. One of the things I would change in the past if I could, would be to prioritise my life in a Godly way. I know that my children would of benefited greatly.

Back in those years I could not read or write music, and played solely by ear. Even now I play most of the time by ear or spontaneously,. I am not a trained musician in any sense, what I have is what the Lord has given me. My mother did try to have me taught by various music teachers but after five of them did what they could for me, mom decided to let my ability with music mature naturally. I am grateful to her for allowing things to take their course, without knowing it mom was letting the Lord have His way.

My knowledge of music theory, has been gleaned from different sources, I am able to compose melodies and I have taught myself to sight-read music, although I prefer the freedom of playing spontaneously for the purpose of expressing what the Holy Spirit is impressing upon my heart. This ability has been a blessing. It is wonderful to be able to paint 'musical pictures' for the Lord, and for the pleasure of my King Jesus who gave me the ability in the first place.

The Call

As I have previously mentioned I was widowed at a very young age. It was during this season of widowhood where with little regular income. I had thought of recording music to sell so as to make ends meet. Yet the more I considered this, the more I realized that the motive behind doing such a thing would not be the heart of God for me. I believe that the motive behind anything we do must primarily have the Kingdom of God at the heart of it. The Holy Spirit loves touching and restoring the lives of those who open their hearts to Him, and to advance the kingdom of God in and through us. So it is very important that our motives are pure before the Lord Jesus Christ.

"Abba Father play Your heart through me"

As I sat behind the piano with both hands on my lap. My heart cried out to Abba and said "Father, what is the use of putting a whole lot of music on a CD if all people might say is that "it is nice music" and then all go their individual ways without being touched, blessed, changed by You? Lord, the only music that will change hearts is the music of heaven;?"

“Lord what is the music of heaven?”

But Lord what is the music of heaven? What is the music of Your heart/ What does it really sound like? I began praying, and as I continued, I felt an incredible longing to hear my heavenly Father's heart. God had been faithful, and the fellowship (church) I was part of had been experiencing awesome times in His presence. Yet somehow I know there was more, much more to this One who loved me so much and whom I loved. So my heart's cry was **Abba Father please....play your heart through Me.** After praying I just sat there quietly and waited.....no familiar melody or song came into my heart, but after a while, I began to hear music, and as I listened I just rested my hands across the keys of the piano. I sensed the Lord say “Play what you hear”. Slowly and softly I started to play the music I was hearing.

The heavenly music the Holy Spirit was imparting to me was filling the room. I listened like someone standing on the outside looking in. As the music continued, I was aware that the music was in a minor key While still playing, I sensed the Lord saying “Yes ,my daughter, the same relationship of love I have with You, I want with My people Israel. As much as you love Me...love them, , pray for them”. He continued ? Pray that my people Israel would know my love revealed to them through Messiah Jesus Christ . Let both Jew and gentile drink from the fountain of life found in My Son,”. Remember I so loved the world that I gave my only begotten Son that whosoever believes in Him would not perish but have everlasting life. What followed was almost indescribable. I sat for a few more moments at the piano, convicted by my own lack of prayer for God's beloved people Israel. I have drunk from the wells of salvation, I enjoy a growing friendship with my heavenly Father, made possible by His Son Jesus Christ, a Jew, and I was enjoying our relationship so much that I had almost forgotten what it cost Him. It cost Him everything.....death on a cross.

Keep the cross at the centre of your life, He died to bring you into a living relationship with the Father, through the Son and by the power of the Holy Spirit. And He rose so that you would experience His resurrection power living through you in the abundant life He has for you.

It has been my experience that no matter what I am going through, as I have chosen to fix my eyes on the goodness, greatness and holiness of God, and the fact that His love endures forever! I have seen many, many breakthroughs in many, many areas. We need to lose sight of our own circumstances and fix our eyes on the One with whom nothing is impossible. See the victory Jesus Christ has won for us in the Spiritual realm and you will see the manifestation in the natural realm, keep a heart of thanksgiving and praise consistent to the Lord.

Receiving music from the Abba

“Abba Father play Your heart through me” was one of the first piece of music I received from the Lord after a wonderful encounter with Him. I pray that you have been blessed by the testimony which formed its foundation, and many others which have followed it through the years as God confirmed to me and through others, that His calling upon my life as that of a Psalmist.

Calling - character - commissioning

Like many of us, I am still on a journey with the Lord, I haven't arrived but I am a lot further down the road than I used to be! Abba Father has **called** us to be conformed to the image of His son Jesus Christ. We are to be partakers of His **divine nature**. It is this anointing that will transform the music into what becomes an extension of the heart of God and something He can anoint. God needs to be able to trust me with what He has given me. My cry is “Father let me represent You in truth of who You really are”. There is a daily yielding and surrendering to the will of the Lord in every area of life, for it is only the outworking of God's purposes and plan in a persons life that will yield the fruit that glorifies the Lord and advances His kingdom.

An orphan doesn't feel loved or accepted

I need to mention that although there was this incredible desire to serve the Lord with everything I had within me. I had a partial understanding of the word of the Lord and what He was calling me to. I knew it was the sonship and the calling of a priestly ministry unto the Lord, to which we are all called. I didn't feel loved by anyone, and neither did I truly love people, much less myself. There was this void inside me and a huge need to be accepted, be part of and to belong.

The fact that I had natural musical talent didn't fill that void, and neither did all my efforts of trying to gain acceptance by what I did rather than who I was. What made matters worse was that I was out there in the world using my musical talents and abilities in a way that caused an even greater emptiness in my heart because I was used and abused rather than accepted and loved.

The reality is simply that as the body of Christ we truly need to help guide people into sonship by placing priority and value on the person and their relationship with the Lord, rather than any of their gifting or abilities. In more recent years this has been the case in the Church I am involved in at present.

I have come to the full realisation that my heavenly Father loves me and has always loved me!! Long before I was born. He just needed me to come to that realisation by firstly accepting Jesus as my Lord, and then knowing that I was fully loved and fully accepted.

Yes God has given me natural musical abilities, but more than that, He has given me Himself through what His Son Jesus Christ has done for me on the cross. Knowing that I am now fully accepted in the Beloved, has brought me to the place of not having to prove anything to anybody. So whether they accept or reject me. I know who I am in Christ.....I am His, and all I have been given is His. The Lord Himself has equipped me to be a blessing to His body and to tell His people that they too can come to the place of rest in the confidence of simply knowing that they too can be 'accepted in the Beloved'. To God be the glory, great things He has done.

On my journey into sonship and the calling of a priestly ministry unto the Lord, to which we are all called. I didn't feel loved by anyone, and neither did I love myself either. I would encourage anyone who has a desire to learn a musical instrument with the purpose of ministering firstly to the Lord, and then and only then to the body of Christ. I cannot emphasise enough that It was only later in life when I gave my heart to the Lord Jesus Christ and became born again that the giftings which God had invested in my life for the advancement of His kingdom really matured both spiritually and technically. Before that the music was just that.....music, with no spiritual content or purpose. It is truly my prayer that your instrument becomes an extension of a heart of worship to the Lord Jesus Christ, and that your one and only goal is to see Him glorified and lifted up.

There are many accomplished and professional musicians out there, and I am not saying that we should not do what we do well. The Lord tells us to play 'skilfully' upon our instruments, but we cannot ever do one to the exclusion of the other, what we do needs to be motivated by love, love for the Lord and love for each other, and this can truly only happen once we come into an understanding of God's love for us through Jesus Christ.

Many of us go through trials and tribulations. I have been through many of them and have many, many testimonies of God's faithfulness, goodness and provision in the midst of it.



The Lord has taught me how to love in the face of bitterness, stand in the face of fear, Believe in the face of poverty, be still in the face of abuse, accusations and lies and to be content with the all sufficiency I have **‘in Him’**.

Life continued and even though I had come to the place of accepting the fact the I was fully loved and fully accepted, there were still the final dregs of an orphan mentality which needed to be dealt with. I didn't quite know how to **receive and give love**, and yet I so enjoyed expressing my worship for the Lord in music. And in my own way I truly loved the Lord, The understanding of His unconditional love just hadn't quite sunk in.

People pleasing ran so deep that I often even violated my core values by doing what people asked me to do. I didn't know how to follow my heart and be real when I needed to say 'No'. I would 'go with the flow' and use scripture which justified the whole thing when at heart I didn't gel in the Spirit. At times deep down I knew it was the musical ability that was accepted and not me as a person **and worst of all it was fruitless and in many instances throughout the years, God Himself was not glorified either!!** Sadly to say that was even true in church circles. I would go so far as to say that as the body of Christ we truly need to place priority and value on the person and their relationship with the Lord, rather than any of their gifting or abilities.

I have come to the full realisation that my heavenly Father loves me and has always loved me!! Long before I was born. He just needed me to come to the realisation of knowing that I was fully loved and fully accepted. Yes, God in His great goodness has given me natural musical abilities, but more than that, He has given me Himself through what His Son Jesus Christ has done for me on the cross.

Knowing that I am fully accepted in the Beloved, has brought me to the place of not having to prove anything to anybody not through music or any other ability. So whether people accept or reject me I know who I am in Christ.....I am His, and all I have been given is His. The Lord Himself has equipped me to be a blessing to His body and to tell His people that they too can come to the place of rest in the confidence of simply knowing that they too can be **‘accepted in the Beloved’**.

And so dearly beloved of the Lord, as I renew my mind with the word of the Lord, spend time with my Abba, allow Him to change me from glory to glory, He manifests Himself through the fibre of all He has invested in my life.

The reason we are here on earth is to bring the Lord pleasure. So bringing Him pleasure, in our thoughts, our deeds, our relationships and our words is all part of a lifestyle of worship. In other words, Jesus Christ is Lord of all we do and all we are. To Him be all the glory.

As I mention in the music teaching aids, one's personal life has a direct impact on effectiveness and fruitfulness in serving the purposes of God's kingdom.

You cannot live according to the flesh for six days and week and then think that on Sundays all is going to be well, and the worship is going to bring glory to God simply because you have the ability to play an instrument. It simply doesn't work like that.

So it is with that thought that I close this part of my testimony, I encourage you to yield to the Lord with your whole heart. Seek Him and know His purpose and plan for your life. Know this, you are greatly loved by the Lord, His death on the cross to redeem you to the Father is enough to demonstrate that love. Draw near to Him in childlike faith, and He will draw near to you. As you rest in His presence, expect to hear the voice of the Holy Spirit, as you cultivate a lifestyle of intimacy with the Father and know the beauty of **"a hearing heart"**.

(4) I have glorified You upon the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me to do.

(5) And now Father, glorify Me with Yourself with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

(6) I have revealed Your name to the men whom You gave to Me out of the world. They were Yours, and You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word.

(7) Now they have known that all things, whatever You have given Me, are from You.

(8) For I have given to them the Words which You gave Me, and they have received *them* and have known surely that I came out from You. And they have believed that You sent Me.

(9) I pray for them. I do not pray for the world, but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours.

(10) And all Mine are Yours, and Yours *are* Mine; and I am glorified in them.

(11) And now I am in the world no longer, but these are in the world, and I come to You, Holy Father. Keep them in Your name, those whom You have given Me, so that *they* may be one as We *are*.

(12) While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name. Those that You have given Me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled.

(13) And now I come to You, and these things I speak in the world **that they might have My joy fulfilled in them.**

(14) I have **given them Your Word**, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

(15) I do not pray for You to take them out of the world, but for You to keep them from the evil.

(16) They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

(17) **Sanctify them through Your truth. Your Word is truth.**

(18) As You have **sent Me into the world**, even so I have **sent them into the world.**

(19) And I sanctify Myself for their sakes, so that they also might be sanctified in truth.

(20) And I do not pray for these alone, but for those also who shall believe on Me through their word,

(21) that they all may be one, as You, Father, *are* in Me, and I in You, that they also may be one in Us, so that the world may believe that You have sent Me.

(22) And I have given them the glory which You have given Me, that they may be one, even as We are one,

(23) **I in them, and You in Me, that they may be made perfect in one;** and that the world may know that **You have sent Me and have loved them** as **You have loved Me.**

(24) **Father, I desire that *those* whom You have given Me, that they may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me, for You have loved Me before *the* foundation of *the* world.**

(25) **O righteous Father, indeed the world has not known You; but I have known You, and these have known that You have sent me.**

(26) And I made known to them Your name, and will make *it* known, so that the love *with* which You have loved Me may be in them, and I in them.

My Blessings Page

Crouzon syndrome is a genetic disorder characterized by the premature fusion of certain skull bones (craniosynostosis). This early fusion prevents the skull from growing normally and affects the shape of the head and face. Many features of Crouzon syndrome result from the premature fusion of the skull bones. Abnormal growth of these bones leads to wide-set, **bulging eyes** and **vision problems** caused by **shallow eye sockets**; eyes that do not point in the same direction (strabismus); **a beaked nose**; and an **underdeveloped upper jaw**. In addition, people with Crouzon syndrome may have **dental problems** and **hearing loss, which is sometimes accompanied by narrow ear canals**. A few people with Crouzon syndrome have an opening in the lip and the roof of the mouth (cleft lip or **cleft palate**). The severity of these signs and symptoms varies among affected people. People with Crouzon syndrome are usually of **normal intelligence**. *(I have bold texted the symptoms that were prevalent in my case) .*

Restored

My first husband passed away in 1989, and I went through a season of widowhood which lasted eleven years. I am now married to a wonderful man who has never been married before. I had a childhood dream to one day marry in the purity of the Lord, so I rejoice to say that God is His great love has caused that dream to come true. We have now been happily married for twenty three years, I have indeed been restored!

I have had my drivers licence since 1990 after been told I might never get my licence due to poor eyesight. Praise God I have been driving since 1990 !! Oh the goodness and grace of God, even when we don't deserve it!!

At one stage I had lost all my musical instruments and all that was left was a shofar. I am happy to say that the Lord has more than restored them back to me, a violin, a piano accordion, a ukulele, a flute and a whole bunch of recorders have been added to the guitars, two keyboards and the piano. The faithfulness of God!
